I should like to respond to your generosity towards me by transferring the £890 I received in cash to the Jubilee Parish Renewal Fund which is launched today. This fund marks both the Golden Jubilee of St Win's Church, which we are celebrating this year, and the Platinum Jubilee of St John's Church, which we will celebrate next year. Special envelopes will be available soon. Like all good Catholics, I have GiftAided this donation so that the fund will initially stand at £890 + 25% = £1,112.50. Needless to say, I'm keeping the wine and the chocolates. The year-end accounts are not yet finalised but it looks like our parish debt is approximately £35,000 (which is not good for the parish priest's mental health) so I am hoping this new fund will help us to get back in the black quickly in an organised and pro-active way.
